
To Whom It May Concern:

I would like to extend this letter of recommendation in respect to the services provided Exelon Nuclear by National Conductor Constructors (NCC) at Clinton Power Station. Their scope of the work included two scopes on our MPT Main Power Transformer (MPT) ISO-Phase bus ducts. The first scope involved maintenance and inspections. NCC provided inspections and cleaning of the ISO-Phase, installation of new gasket material as needed, cleaning of all accessible insulators, borescopic camera and still photos of the bus and insulators, concluding the work with a final report. Part 2 of the work scope included the Installation of new dampers at each MPT including the main generator. NCC cut and removed the existing shorting plates to allow for the removal of the old dampers; prepared the shorting plates to receive new plating material to ensure proper fit-up and continuity after completion of the required aluminum welding. Their employees are ASTM and ANSI /AWS TIG certified aluminum welders. The project was rather challenging due to the shortened work schedule duration included as part of the outage. Therefore, the coordination and communication with NCC was crucial in completing the project on time to support the testing requirements to take the unit back online. NCC exceeded every expectation.

Their performance continues to live up to the high standards we (Exelon) set for our contractors. NCC performance excelled in all categories, including: customer contact; safety; adherence to schedule; caliber of supervision; quality workmanship; attention to detail; and also, with great importance, costs.
